Sarah Gioffre provided an overview of the program and the proposed applications (see attached). Ms. Gioffre noted that the 2020 CT Neighborhood Assistance Act Tax Credit is designed to provide funding for Municipal and Tax Exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses that make cash contributions to these organizations. Business can receive a credit of 60% of their approved contributions to certain programs and in some cases up to 100% in the case of certain energy conservation programs that are approved by the Department of Revenue Services. Ms. Gioffre responded to questions.
