LEGAL NOTICE OF ANNUAL TOWN MEETING

All electors of the Town of Wilton and all others entitled to vote at a meeting of the Town Meeting pursuant to the General Statutes are hereby notified that the ANNUAL TOWN MEETING of the Town of Wilton will be held in the **Middlebrook School Auditorium, Wilton, Connecticut on Tuesday, May 4, 2010, at 7:30 P.M.** to consider and act upon the following matters:

1. The Annual Budget and tax levy for the Town of Wilton set forth below and submitted by the Board of Finance for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2010, and to make specific appropriations as are advisable and authorized by law.
2. Resolution Appropriating \$250,000 For The Planning And Design Of Siding And Roofing Renovations At Miller Driscoll School And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$250,000 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation.
3. Resolution Appropriating \$150,000 For The Planning And Design Of Roofing Repairs And Improvements At Middlebrook School And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$150,000 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation.
4. Resolution Appropriating \$550,000 For Exterior Window Replacement At Middlebrook School And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$550,000 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation.

Upon motions duly made and adopted by majority vote, it was resolved to:

1. Recommend to the Annual Town Meeting the appropriation of a budget for expenditures amounting to \$108,695,022 for Fiscal 2011.
2. Levy a tax of 20.16 mils on the Net Taxable Grand List of October 1, 2009 that is payable one-half on July 1, 2010 and one-half on January 1, 2011, except for bills of \$100 or less and for personal property taxes on automobiles, which shall be payable in one installment on July 1, 2010.

3. Recommend to the Annual Town Meeting the opportunity for voters and electors of the Town of Wilton to consider three projects proposed by the Board of Education that would be financed by bonds of the Town of Wilton.
