## Public Meeting on Draft Town Plan

**WILTON** –The Wilton Planning and Zoning Commission is holding a public meeting to hear input from residents on the Draft Plan of Conservation and Development. Attendees will get an overview of the Draft Plan and then have the opportunity to comment on goals and strategies for Wilton’s future.

On May 18, copies of the Draft Plan will be available for reviewing at the Library Reference Desk and at the Planning and Zoning Department in the Town Hall annex. The Plan will also be available on the Town’s website at [www.wiltonct.org/departments/planning](http://www.wiltonct.org/departments/planning) by May 14.

“This Plan will guide future conservation and development activity over the next decade and beyond,” said Sally Poundstone, Chair of the Planning and Zoning Commission. “The input we have heard from residents and town officials over the past year helped us as we drafted the plan. We hope residents will review the Plan and let us know if they think that plan will guide Wilton in the right direction.”

After hearing from residents, the Commission will amend the Plan as needed and then forward it to the Board of Selectmen for its review. The Commission aims to adopt the Plan in the fall.

Preparation of the Plan is being coordinated by Planimetrics, an Avon-based consulting land use planning and consulting firm. The most recent Plan of Conservation and Development for the Town was adopted in 1999.
